ELIGIBILITY: By qualification per Central and Rocky Division rules. All U.S. Ski & Snowboard rules apply.

ATHLETE FEE: \$600.00 – includes credential and all fees for training and race days, athlete tubing and pizza party, BBQ and swag. Winter Park or IKON pass holders can receive a \$50 discount when registering. No discount/refund for athletes not competing in all events.

ENTRY PROCEDURE: Electronically at <https://www.u16jrchampionships.com>. Athlete (parent) is responsible for completing all race entry forms in their entirety. Entry fees must accompany entry. All registrations must be received no later than March 3, 2023.

RACE HEADQUARTERS: Balcony House at Winter Park Base, third level.

CREDENTIAL PICK UP: Race Headquarters, Sunday 2:00 – 4:00 pm, Monday and Tuesday 7:00 – 10:00 am. Competition Center Office Hours Monday, March 6 – Sunday, March 8 - 8:00 am – 4:00 pm.

FAMILY LIFT TICKETS: Preordered Family ticket \$84.00/day. Go to tinyurl.com/wpiftickets and **change the date** to the first day of skiing before adding tickets to your cart. Walk up sales will incur an extra \$10/day ticket charge. Discounted lift tickets are available to immediate family members only. All purchased tickets will be checked against the list of registered athletes.

U16 COACH: Coaches must be licensed by US Ski and Snowboard and have appropriate certifications. The “Coach Packet” with registration instructions is available at www.u16jrchampionships.com. Completed forms and online waivers must be completed and returned no later than March 3 to kkolar@winterparkresort.com. Coach credentials will be issued according to the schedule on the packet with additional credentials available for \$250 and includes lift pass, BBQ, and social mixer.
